(TRACS), has been an Okanagan based charitable organization since 1994. We are dedicated to the kind and compassionate treatment of all living beings. In addition to hands on rescue work and crisis intervention, we actively promote awareness in areas where animals are exploited for profit, abused, or denied natural conditions.

TRACS is an all volunteer group and relies entirely on donations, grants and fundraising. Funds go directly to animal care with minimal administrative costs.

Miscellaneous Animal Rescue

We help provide medical care for abandoned animals, sterilization and food for feral cats, and assistance to low income citizens with sick pets.

Sanctuary

In 2008, an epidemic of free roaming rabbits was created when domestic pets were abandoned. Working with the City of Kelowna, TRACS humanely trapped over 800 rabbits who are now sterilized, live in specialized sanctuaries and are provided with food, shelter and veterinary care. Our trained volunteers provide much needed socialization for the bunnies.

Adoptions

On occasion we have an abandoned or surrendered animal needing a new home. With careful screening procedures in place we strive to find them the best "forever" homes possible.

Education

Our goal is to give people the knowledge and resources to make educated and responsible decisions regarding animal welfare.

Disasters

The TRACS team is trained and dedicated to animal welfare in times of emergencies when domestic animals are in need of rescue and shelter.

Donations

One of the easiest ways to help is with a monetary donation. We have numerous options including our Bunny Sponsorship program. A very small portion goes to administration costs with the majority going directly to the care of the animals.
